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## Camarillo Man Pleads Guilty in \$1.8 Million Insurance Fraud Case

VENTURA, Calif. - District Attorney Erik Nasarenko announced today that a nearly \$2 million insurance fraud case has led to a guilty plea by defendant Steven F. Gordon (DOB 08/18/54) of Camarillo.

On November 1, 2022, Gordon pled guilty in Ventura County Superior Court to nine counts of felony grand theft and admitted a special allegation of taking more than \$500,000.

Gordon, an insurance agent, stole more than \$1.8 million from three clients between September 2014 and November 2020. He was arrested on August 21, 2021.

The years-long fraud investigation was led by the California Department of Insurance. Senior Deputy District Attorney Howard A. Wise, a member of the Ventura County District Attorney's Office Fraud and Technology Crimes Unit, prosecuted the case.

Sentencing is scheduled for December 28, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. in courtroom 12 of the Ventura County Superior Court.
