VENTURA, California - District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced today that David Llamas (DOB: 3/9/70), of Santa Paula, was sentenced by Judge Patricia Murphy to 48 years and eight months to life in prison. In December 2011, a jury found Llamas guilty of aggravated sexual assault (rape) of a child under age 14, continuous sexual abuse of a child under the age of 14, and lewd acts upon a child aged 14 and 15.

At jury trial, Llamas' two step-daughters testified. One step-daughter testified that Llamas began to sexually abuse her when she was approximately seven years old. This victim testified that the sexual abuse continued on a regular basis until 2010 when Llamas' conduct was reported to the police. At the time of the reporting, this victim was 16 years old. The second step-daughter testified that Llamas began to sexually abuse her when she was 4 or 5 years old. This victim testified that the sexual abuse continued on a regular basis until after she turned 14 years old when the abuse was reported to the police in 2010. Llamas told each victim that they were not to tell anyone about the abuse and that if they failed to submit to the abuse, he would molest the victims' younger sisters.

A third female juvenile who was a member of Llamas' extended family testified at trial that Llamas had sexually abused her when she was seven to ten years old.
