



**Ventura County D.A. Continues to Provide Support for Victims
of the Las Vegas Route 91 Harvest Festival Concert Shooting**

In the wake of the deadliest mass shooting in U.S. history, District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced today that victim advocates from the Ventura County District Attorney's Office are assisting the Nevada Attorney General's office in coordinating a response to the more than 22,000 victims of this tragedy. Ventura County families, including victims from Camarillo, Oxnard, Simi Valley, and Thousand Oaks, have suffered the ultimate loss with the tragic and senseless death of a loved one. Countless others from our County were injured in the melee, and all who were there may have suffered trauma.

The District Attorney's Crime Victims' Assistance Unit has been deployed locally since the morning after the tragedy providing counseling, therapy, emergency assistance, funeral and burial expenses, property return and notification to friends and family, as well as additional services provided by local and federal agencies. They have served as a liaison with the Las Vegas Coroner's Office providing accurate and timely information to the families of deceased victims and have been coordinating with the FBI to register all victims and next of kin.

Anyone present at the concert that night is eligible for assistance. No crime report is needed. Some psychological or physical injuries may manifest themselves weeks, months or years later. The District Attorney's Office encourages all concert attendees to contact the District Attorney's Crime Victim's Assistance Unit at (805) 654-3622 to complete an application to receive assistance.
