





**Man Sentenced to 18 Years to Life for Murder and Concealment of Victim's Body in Freezer**

*VENTURA, California* – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced that Michael Bresnak (DOB 12/22/63), of Ventura, was sentenced by Judge Gilbert Romero to a term of 18 years to life in prison after a jury found Bresnak guilty of the second-degree murder by strangulation of victim Jeffrey Korber. On March 22, 2011, Bresnak murdered the victim and hid his body in a freezer at a storage unit in the city of Ventura. Although the victim was reported missing immediately, information received by Ventura Police Department detectives over two years later led to the discovery of the victim's body in the freezer.
