**17-Year-Old Male Charged in Shooting Death at Oxnard Hotel**

*VENTURA, California* – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced that a 17-year-old male has been charged with murder and personal use of a firearm for the July 1, 2018, shooting death of Donald Reyes, Jr., of Thousand Oaks.

The shooting occurred in the early morning hours within a room at the Homewood Suites Hotel in Oxnard. The case was investigated by the Oxnard Police Department.

This minor remains detained pending arraignment on July 13, 2018, at 8:30 a.m. at the Juvenile Justice Center. A motion to transfer the case to adult court was filed by the District Attorney's Office.

If tried as an adult, the minor faces a maximum sentence of 50 years to life in prison.
