Oxnard Man Found Guilty of Firearm Offenses

VENTURA, California – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced that a jury found Efren Salomon (DOB 02/09/86), of Oxnard, guilty of conspiracy to unlawfully transfer firearms and being a felon in possession of a firearm and ammunition. The jury also found that the conspiracy was committed in association with and for the benefit of a criminal street gang. The jury found Salomon not guilty of an unrelated charge of being a felon in possession of a firearm.

Salomon will be sentenced on August 22, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. in courtroom 24 of the Ventura Superior Court, County of Ventura. Salomon faces a maximum possible sentence of 11 years 4 months in prison.
