**Former Camarillo Resident Charged with Brother's Murder**

*VENTURA, California* – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced today that Luis Sandoval Aceves (DOB 3/23/56) of Federal Way, Washington, has been charged with murder and personally using a knife in the commission of the crime.

The homicide took place on the evening of April 6, 2017, in the city of Camarillo. The victim, Gilbert Aceves, was the defendant's younger brother.

Arraignment for Aceves was continued to August 28, 2018. He is currently in custody with bail set at \$3 million. If convicted, Aceves faces a maximum sentence of 26 years to life in state prison.
