Oxnard Man Sentenced to 26 Years for Assault with a Firearm

VENTURA, California – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced today that Raymundo Lopez (DOB 11/30/96), of Oxnard, was sentenced to 26 years in prison by Judge Bruce Young. In August 2018, Lopez pled guilty to one count of assault with a firearm with special allegations that he personally used a firearm, personally inflicted great bodily injury, and that he committed the assault for the benefit of a criminal street gang.

In December 2016, Lopez fired multiple gunshots at a 17-year-old victim while claiming the name of his criminal street gang. The victim suffered three gunshot wounds to his hand, hip, and lower leg. Officers interviewed an Uber driver who was able to provide the license plate identification of Lopez's getaway vehicle. Through their investigation, Oxnard Police detectives obtained a surveillance video of Lopez and two other individuals, which showed them linked to the vehicle the night of the shooting. After executing multiple search warrants, officers recovered the firearm hidden in a tree in the backyard of Lopez's residence.
