Woman Convicted of Felony Vehicular Manslaughter While Intoxicated

VENTURA, California – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced today that Georgia Casey (DOB 10/30/1986), of Ventura, pled guilty to several felony charges, including vehicular manslaughter while intoxicated. Casey also admitted an allegation of fleeing the scene of a crime that resulted in a death.

On April 25, 2017, just before 8:00 a.m., Casey drove an SUV into the Ventura County Government Center complex. At that same time, Ms. Estella Tejeda Camacho was walking to work on the sidewalk adjacent to the roadway. Casey drove onto the sidewalk and struck Ms. Tejeda Camacho. Casey momentarily stopped the vehicle before fleeing the scene. Ms. Tejeda Camacho died as a result of the injuries she suffered.

The prosecution of this case was the result of the hard work and thorough investigation conducted by the Ventura Police Department's Traffic Unit.

Sentencing for Casey is scheduled on February 4, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. in courtroom 12 of the Ventura Superior Court, County of Ventura. Casey faces a maximum prison sentence of 15 years for this case and unrelated theft and drug charges.
