



Woman Sentenced for Child Endangerment

VENTURA, California – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced today that Judge Manuel Covarrubias sentenced Maryann Salazar (DOB 7/16/1991), a transient, to 261 days in the Ventura County jail, 48 months of formal probation and 52 weeks of child abuse classes for child endangerment and obstructing a peace officer. Salazar pled guilty to the charges on December 26, 2018.

On September 17, 2018, Salazar, while holding an eight-month-old infant, climbed to the fourth story roof of 21 California Street in Ventura, via the exterior fire escape ladder. Salazar sat on the edge of the roof with the infant, prompting a concerned citizen and the Ventura Police Department to intervene.
