Ventura Man Convicted of Domestic Violence Charges

VENTURA, California – District Attorney Gregory D. Totten announced today that Daniel John Marcus (DOB 05/30/1986), of Ventura, was convicted by a jury of inflicting corporal injury on a cohabitant, dissuading a witness by force or violence, and false imprisonment. Marcus was further found to have inflicted great bodily injury on the victim. The jury returned these verdicts on January 23, 2019. The court found that Marcus had prior convictions of kidnapping and criminal threats against a prior domestic violence victim.

Sentencing for Marcus is scheduled March 5, 2019, at 8:30 a.m. in courtroom 21 of the Ventura Superior Court, County of Ventura. Due to his prior convictions, Marcus is eligible for sentencing under California's Three Strikes sentencing statute and faces a maximum possible sentence of 61 years 4 months to life in prison.
