Transient Defendant Sentenced to 21 Years for Gun Crimes

VENTURA, Calif. - District Attorney Erik Nasarenko announced that on Thursday, December 8, 2022, transient defendant June Glandros (DOB 04/10/96), was sentenced to 21 years in state prison.

In September 2022, Glandros was convicted or pled guilty to several counts, including the charged gun allegations, for three separate crimes that occurred in 2021 and 2022. A jury convicted Glandros of discharge of a firearm with gross negligence and illegal possession of a firearm for a February 16, 2021, shooting in Oxnard. The jury also found the defendant guilty of three counts of assault with a firearm and illegal possession of a firearm for an April 2022 shooting that wounded three people at a Ventura tattoo parlor.

Prior to the jury trial, Glandros had pled guilty to counts charging illegal possession of a firearm and possession of a large capacity magazine for a December 2021 arrest by the Oxnard Police Department. The December and April incidents happened while Glandros was out on bail for previous crimes.

"I am satisfied with the jury verdict and the sentencing, as both reflect the enormity of the crimes and the defendant's recidivism while out on bail," said prosecuting attorney Theresa Pollara. "The three crimes committed on different dates and in different locations within our county, the last two while out on bail, illustrate the defendant's unwillingness to follow the law. Of great importance in the sentencing requested by the District Attorney's Office was the defendant's total lack of remorse for his actions and his transfer of blame to the victims."
